Goals

- Provide a vibrant, interactive artistic experience for patrons of all ages and an artist
- Give our patrons a chance to view and learn about art forms in various media
- Create an opportunity for artists to promote and further develop an audience for their art

Basic Details of Residence

- Four week residency to take place in the early fall at the Johnson County Library
- An opportunity for the artist to meet patrons in an interactive educational environment
- Public programs, presented by the artist, on his work and creative experiences
- Formal reception held during the residency, including public officials, Foundation donors, local art patrons and library friends.
- Exclusive display of artist's work during residency
- Extensive promotion of residency throughout the Kansas City metropolitan area in newspapers, radio, and on library Web site.
- Paid stipend, mileage stipend and expenses

Application Requirements

- Application deadline is February 1
- A successful applicant will provide:
 - Letter stating qualifications, program vision, and benefits to the library and community
 - Artist statement
 - Resume complete with biographical information, awards/honors, shows, and description of art work
 - Samples of work in a digital or print format
