Directions:

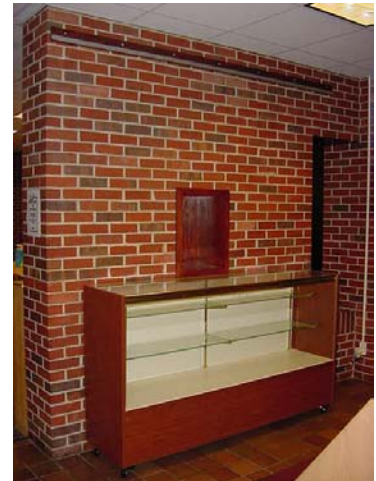
If traveling North on Roe avenue, take the first left turn available after you pass the traffic light at 55th street. You will be on Rosewood. Follow it three blocks to Cedar, turn right. Go one block and it is on your left.

Traveling South on 18th Street Expressway from I-35, turn right on West 50th place past the Firststar bank. Go to Cedar St., turn left and continue on past the church located just west of Walmart.



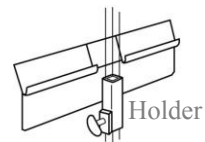
The space consists of a brick display wall which measures 8 feet wide x 4 feet high above the case where the artwork will be attached to special mounting devices so that the artwork will gently rest against the wall.

There is one locked display case, located in the center of the wall. The case has six shelves (including bottom of display case), approximately 18 inches deep and 70 inches in length. Florescent lighting is provided within the display case for lighting highlight.

The picture system is a very workable example of artistic design. It operates through a series of sleeves, hooks and holders. The initial step in the system involves a permanent molding attached to the wall and supports the Rods and hooks that hold the artwork. The sleeves and rods are attached over the lip of the molding with holders on the rods to support the wire of the artwork, involving less hassle of straightening and adjusting.



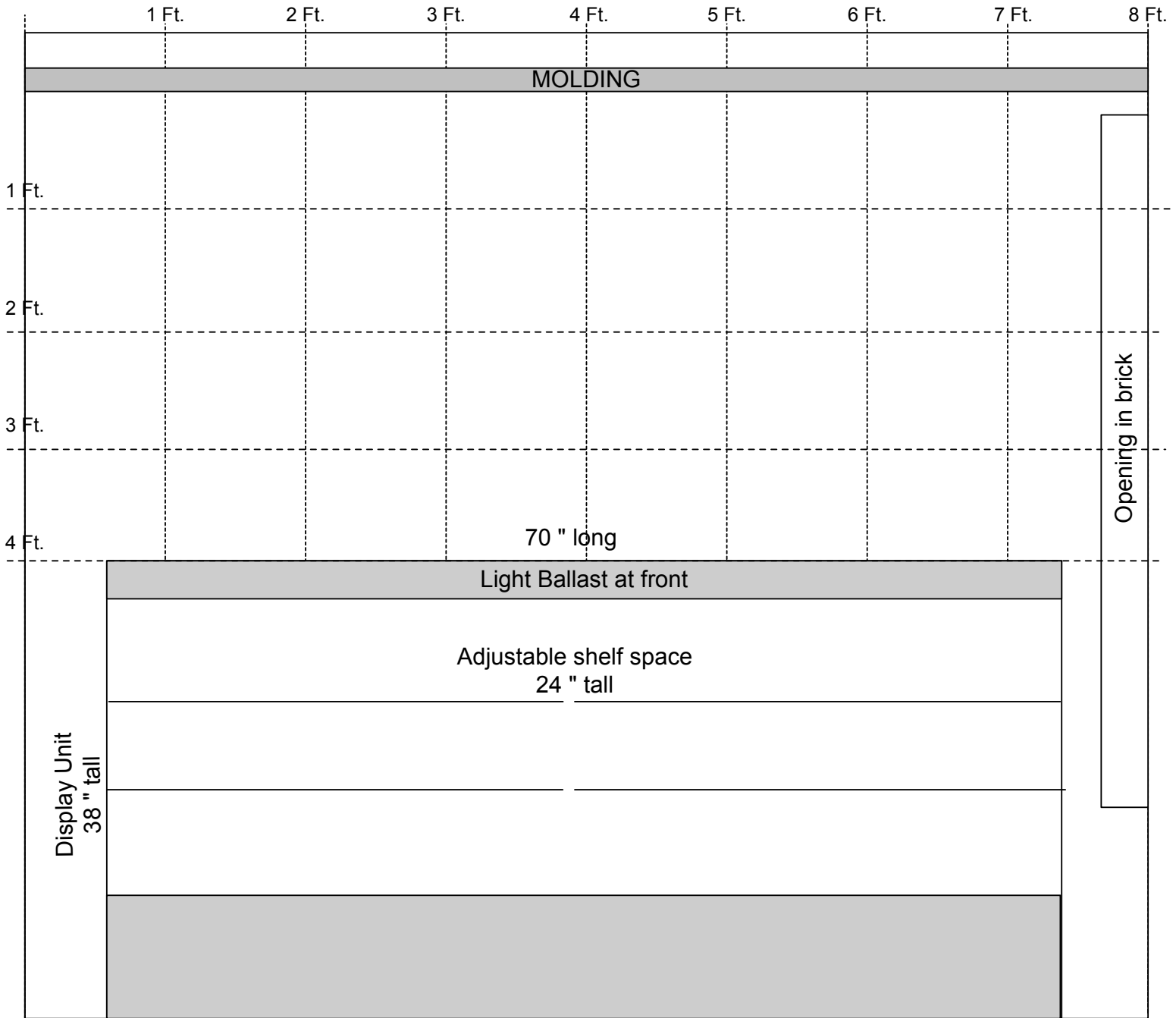
