- 1. Categories: Preschool-Kdg. Grades 1-2 Grades 3-4 Grades 5-6 Grades 7-8 Grades 9-12 Adult (Two winners in each category.)
- 2. Limit one entry per submitter.
- 3. Bookmark design must be original work. Nothing previously published accepted. Popular figures (ex. Superman, Disney, etc.) cannot be considered due to copyright restrictions.
- 4. Books, libraries and/or reading should be included in the design.
- 5. Bookmarks may be created in color or black-and-white.

Acceptable media:

- Flat 2-dimensional graphics and collage on paper or paper board.
- Colored pencil, marker, crayon, gouache, tempera, oil, acrylic, fingerpaint, chalk, watercolor, pen-and-ink.
- No photography or digital imagery.
- Glitter and reflectives do not reproduce well and are discouraged.
- Entries are valid only when accompanied by this completed and signed Registration Form.
- ALL YOUR INFORMATION MUST BE CLEAR AND LEGIBLE. INCLUDE A FAMILY OR PERSONAL EMAIL THAT YOU WILL RESPOND TO WHEN WE CONTACT YOU. We'll disqualify submissions whose name or address we cannot read, or if you don't respond to an email.
- Printed entry forms are available at our questions desks.

Completed entry forms may be returned at any of the 14 branches.

 Completed entry forms may be returned at elementia.submittable.com starting July 11, 2022.
- 6. Bookmarks will be accepted July 11 Sept. 9, 2022. No entries accepted after midnight, Sept. 9. Entries will not be returned after judging.
- 7. Parent or guardian of submitters under 16 years old must sign the completed form.
- 8. Jurors include Friends of Johnson County Library staff and board, and Johnson County Library staff. Submissions will be judged on originality, theme and creativity. Jurors' decisions are final.
- 9. Winning entries will be printed and available at Johnson County Library branches.
